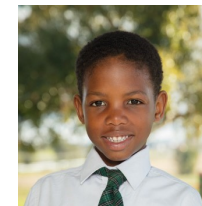

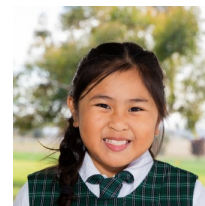

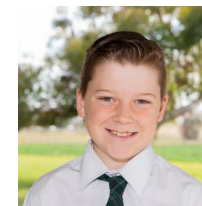

Principal's Comment

We have just passed 'hump day' - the middle day of the term. There are just 4 weeks left until the next holiday break and only a few activities left on the calendar. School events are minimal as a result of health restrictions but there has been great learning happening. One of the benefits has been improved student reading outcomes. All students were provided with an account to access the PM Reading platform when learning from home commenced and this has continued throughout the term. Recent assessments show some students have progressed 1-2 levels.

COVID-19 Update

The current advice for schools includes:

- exclusion of students and staff with even mild 'flu-like' symptoms
- processes for daily screening of students and staff for symptoms
- encouraging immediate testing for any sick children or staff
- prohibiting return to school for anyone who has been tested for COVID (whether they have symptoms or not) until a negative COVID test result is available

• Schools must sight the negative COVID-19 test result prior to allowing students and staff to return to school.

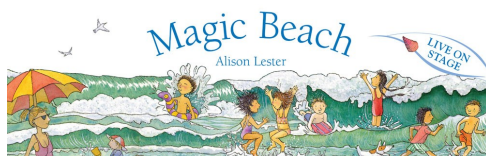


Compass
