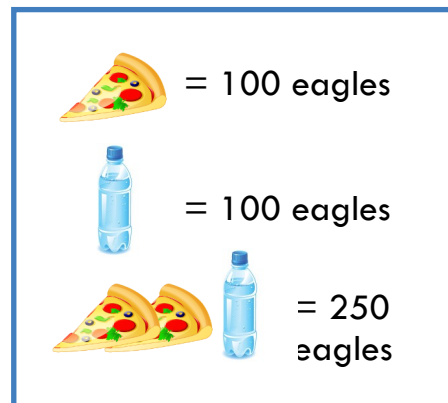
Following Assembly there is a 2-week holiday break. School resumes on Monday April 19. The office is open though the holidays, except for Public Holidays.
