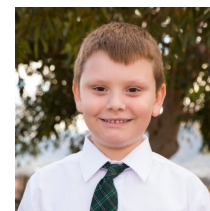

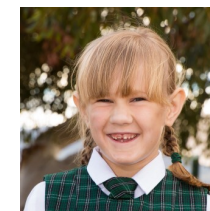

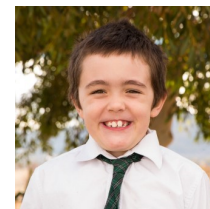

This is a compliance requirement of NESA (National Education Standards Authority) for every school.

School Attendance

School-age children are required to attend school every school day. If children are absent, caregivers are required to provide an explanation for the absence within 7 days. These are government requirements.

At Liberty, we try to make this process as easy as possible. There is currently a trial of a new system. If a child is not at school, an SMS will be sent to caregivers. The SMS has a link to the online absence form on the school webpage. This is a quick process and reduces the need for paper forms getting lost in student bags. Please note that a doctor's certificate may be requested for absences longer than two days.
