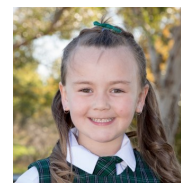

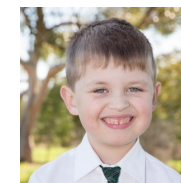

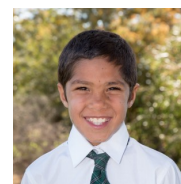

## Principal's Comment

Last week, ground work commenced for the Capital Works Grant. The first job is to move power before installing security gates, widening the driveway and installing the guttering. Buildings are coming later in the year.
